Clerk's Report – 20 March 2023

Update on outstanding items:

M5 Update: Safety barrier work complete.

Other Roadworks:

Ongoing:

- Phase 1 - Electrical Works - 20 February to 20 March 2023 - full closure of the A46 between Aston Cross and Teddington Hands, including three-way temporary traffic lights on A345 and B4077.
- Phase 2 - 21 March to 6 April 2023 - Four-way temporary traffic lights on Teddington Hands roundabout and a full closure of Crashmore Lane and two-way temporary traffic lights on the A435

Upcoming:

- From 27 Mar at 07:00 - 28 Mar at 17:00 – Natton Lane closed. Works Descriptions: Pre-surface dressing retexturing
- Claydon, Fiddington - The road above will be closed (as per the attached plan) from 08.00 on 09/05/23 – 17.00 on 11/05/23. This road closure is required by Severn Trent Water to carry out apparatus renewal in this location. Residential, Emergency and Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Grange Road, Northway (Level Crossing) - The road above will be closed (as per the attached plan) x3 separate weekends between 12/05/23 - 25/06/23.

23.00 on 19/05 – 07.00 on 22/05
21.00 on 24/06 – 10.00 on 25/06
This road closure is required by Network Rail to carry out track renewal in this location. Access will not be maintained due to the nature and safety risk of the works involved.
