PUBLIC PARTICIPATION – TO INCLUDE REPRESENTATIVES STANDING FOR ELECTION AT THE FORTHCOMING BOROUGH COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Mel Gore (Con) MG and Drewe Lacey (Lib/Dem) DL were given 5 minutes to answer questions from members of the parish council and public

MG – Current Borough Councillor of Isbourne Ward stated is hands on, committed, and proactive with parishes, and has lots of local knowledge

DL – less experienced however member of Toddington PCC and previous experience within Stroud District Council, concerned with local issues and community-based projects, feels needs to work as a team as lots of ongoing planning issues, Conservative 6-point plan would overlap on major issues

Q: There are major changes planned for Ashchurch

MG: Concept Plan needs a lot of work before she is happy, some of £750,000 allocated fund would go on a website and office so people could pop in to discuss, has concerns on traffic issues and flooding

A46 will dictate what happens at J9 and J10 can't progress at the moment and we will have to have sound secure polices in place

DL: Limited knowledge but as a resident aware of the frustration in travelling across A46 and noted can't bring in major development unless within regional plan, and infrastructure needs to be sorted in the first place

Q: TBC has promised that infrastructure is already in place to allow some development, and therefore has no confidence in the Council

Q: The funding doesn't guarantee the development will go ahead, it is early design works

At this point DG noted all candidates were invited to attend this meeting and was cross only two had turned up, we have suffered with non-commitment from borough councils for some time

Q: Did MG vote for Master plan?

MG: Yes, I voted for it as part of the JCS

Q: Is it just a concept as feels it is more of a given?

MG: It is still a concept long term plan, there is a TBC shortfall of over 2000 houses

DL: Has experience of planning, it has to have an outline plan and then stops being a concept. Appreciates planning is a major concern as is the case with other parishes non tory councillors would at least question them. Villages need to stay alive and council needs fresh blood.

TD: This Council wants more than a general consultation, i.e. a parish liaison officer and proper meaningful consultation as feels there is no transparency

MG and DL withdrew to discuss issues with members of the public
